

PREDOCTORAL TRAINEESHIP AWARD

*Training future leaders to make an impact on
breast cancer research*

The Predoctoral Traineeship Award prepares promising graduate students with a strong commitment to breast cancer research for successful and competitive careers. This award promotes creative approaches to training breast cancer investigators. Successful trainees will be selected for their talent, potential, and commitment to breast cancer research; the mentor's qualifications and experience in breast cancer research; the strong breast cancer research training program at the trainee's institution; the innovative research environment; and the institution's commitment to training future leaders in breast cancer research. The proposed training must focus on breast cancer research. Approximately \$4 million is available for this award mechanism. Awardees may receive up to \$30,000 per year for a maximum of 3 years (direct and indirect costs).
