

# HBCU/MI COLLABORATIVE RESEARCH AWARD

Foster and sustain independent, competitive ovarian cancer researchers at Historically Black Colleges and Universities/ Minority Institutions (HBCU/MI)



The Fiscal Year 2006 (FY06) **Ovarian Cancer Research Program (OCRP)** offers this award to support HBCU/MI faculty whose ability to establish an ovarian cancer research program is hampered by a lack of resources. This award provides HBCU/MI investigators the opportunity to collaborate with and be mentored by well-established ovarian cancer researcher(s). Applicants must be HBCU/MI doctoral-level faculty members and collaborators must have a strong record of funding in ovarian cancer research. Preliminary data relevant to the proposed project are required.

Preproposals will be screened with special emphasis on the quality of the collaboration, and full proposals will be invited from investigators whose projects fulfill the intent of the award mechanism. Review of the full proposal will emphasize collaboration, mentorship, and professional development of the HBCU/MI investigator.

Funding can be requested for a maximum of \$600,000 for direct costs over a 4-year performance period, plus indirect costs as appropriate.

Invited Full Proposals Are Due By: **June 20, 2006**
