The Fiscal Year 2006 (FY06) **Ovarian Cancer Research Program (OCRP)** supports innovative research in etiology/ tumor biology, preclinical development of targeted therapeutics, or early detection and diagnosis of ovarian cancer through the Idea Development Award. Funded research is expected to have a significant impact on the concepts or methods that drive the field of ovarian cancer research. Applicants must be independent investigators.

Two-page preproposals will be evaluated for impact, research strategy, and innovation and full proposals will be invited from investigators whose projects best fulfill the intent of the award mechanism. Review of full proposals will emphasize impact on ovarian cancer research and/or patient care.

Preliminary data relevant to ovarian cancer and the proposed project are required. Funding can be requested for a maximum of \$500,000 for direct costs over a 3-year performance period, plus indirect costs as appropriate.

Preproposals Are Due By: **March 7, 2006**
Invited Full Proposals Are Due By: **June 20, 2006**
