

HEALTH DISPARITY RESEARCH AWARD

Encouraging and supporting research on the disparity of prostate cancer



The ultimate goal of these **Prostate Cancer Research Program (PCRP)** awards is to resolve the health disparity in prostate cancer incidence, morbidity, and mortality. The applicant or another key investigator on the project must demonstrate experience in prostate cancer research and a connection to, or effectiveness in working with, the affected population or community.

Funding for Health Disparity Research Awards may be requested for a maximum of \$300,000 for direct costs for up to a 3-year performance period, plus indirect costs as appropriate. Funds may cover salary, expenses including research supplies, and travel to scientific or technical meetings.

Proposals should emphasize the potential of the research team, the impact the project will have on prostate cancer disparity, and the research strategy.

Proposals Are Due By:
April 18, 2006
