

NEW INVESTIGATOR AWARD

Inspiring the next generation of
prostate cancer scientists



The New Investigator Award reflects the commitment of the **Prostate Cancer Research Program (PCRP)** to invest in the future of prostate cancer research by supporting promising researchers in the early stages of their careers. This award was designed to recognize and support new investigators who have innovative ideas or new technologies applicable to prostate cancer research or treatment. Preliminary data are not required.

Applicants must be independent investigators within 6 years of completing their last fellowship or postdoctoral position. They may not have received non-mentored research funding as a Principal Investigator (PI) or co-PI in excess of \$100,000 in direct costs in aggregate from extramural sources. Funding for these awards can be requested for up to \$225,000 for direct costs for up to a 3-year performance period plus indirect costs as appropriate.

Proposals should emphasize the potential of the applicant to make a pioneering contribution to the prostate cancer field in terms of innovation, impact, and research strategy.
