

# IDEA DEVELOPMENT AWARD

Reducing the Impact of Tuberous Sclerosis  
Complex through Innovative Research



The Idea Development Award provides support for established investigators to pursue novel research directed toward the **Tuberous Sclerosis Complex Research Program (TSCR)** objective of improving the detection, diagnosis, and treatment of tuberous sclerosis complex. Successful proposals will demonstrate innovation and originality, but **preliminary data relevant to tuberous sclerosis complex are required** to support the feasibility and rationale of the proposed studies. Peer review of Idea Development Award submissions will emphasize innovation, potential impact on tuberous sclerosis complex, and research strategy.

Applicants must be independent investigators at the Assistant Professor level (or equivalent) or higher. Funding may be requested for a maximum of \$400,000 for direct costs over a 3-year performance period, plus indirect costs as appropriate.
