

# IMPACT AWARD

Filling research funding gaps to accelerate the eradication of breast cancer.



The **Breast Cancer Research Program (BCRP)** Impact Award is intended to support unique projects or ideas that do not fit existing BCRP award mechanisms yet possess strong potential to have an unprecedented impact on the prevention, detection, diagnosis, and/or treatment of breast cancer or greatly enhance the quality of life for breast cancer patients.

The most important aspect of this award is the potential of the proposed work to have an exceptionally high impact and contribute significantly to the goal of eradicating breast cancer. Impact is emphasized in both the peer review and the programmatic review of Impact Award proposals.

Impact Awards have no dollar amount restrictions, and therefore funding can be requested for any amount of direct costs over the performance period. Indirect costs should be added, as appropriate. The performance period may be requested for a maximum of 5 years, and no more than \$5M in total costs (direct plus indirect) will be granted in any single year during the lifetime of the award.

Pre-applications are due by **May 22, 2007**

Proposals are due by **June 12, 2007**
