

# PREDOCTORAL TRAINEESHIP AWARD

Training future leaders to make an impact in breast cancer research.



The **Breast Cancer Research Program (BCRP)** Predoctoral Traineeship Award prepares promising graduate students for successful and competitive careers by promoting creative approaches to training breast cancer investigators. Successful applicants will be selected for their talent, potential, and commitment to breast cancer research; the mentor's qualifications and experience in breast cancer research; the strong breast cancer research training program at the trainee's institution; the innovative research environment; and the institution's commitment to training future leaders in breast cancer research.

Funding for this award can be requested for up to \$90,000 for direct costs for up to a 3-year performance period, plus indirect costs as appropriate. Up to \$30,000 per year in direct costs may be requested.

Pre-applications are due by **April 26, 2007**  
Proposals are due by **May 17, 2007**
