<p><b>Impact Award</b></p> <p>Go to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">Program Announcement</a></li> <li>• <a href="#">General Application Instructions</a></li> </ul> <p>Grants.gov Funding Opportunity Number: <b><u>W81XWH-17-PCRP-IA</u></b></p>	<p>Independent investigators at or above the level of Assistant Professor (or equivalent)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Preproposal is required; application submission is by invitation only.</b></li> <li>• Supports high-impact, potentially high-risk, studies (including clinical trials) that address a central question or problem in prostate cancer. As such, the primary emphasis of this mechanism is on impact.</li> <li>• Potential impact of the research is expected to be near-term, and it must be significant and go beyond an incremental advancement.</li> <li>• Proposed projects may include basic, translational, or clinical research, including clinical trials.</li> <li>• Preliminary data to support feasibility are required.</li> <li>• <b>Partnering PI option:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Provides a higher level of funding to support synergistic partnerships between two or three independent investigators collaborating on a single application.</li> <li>○ PIs are expected to demonstrate within the application the synergistic components that will significantly advance the project such that the research outcomes could not otherwise be accomplished through the independent efforts of a single PI.</li> <li>○ Allows for individual awards to multiple sites (maximum of three sites in total), provided the combined direct costs for all sites do not exceed the \$2M maximum.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<p><b>Individual PIs:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maximum funding of <b>\$750K</b> for direct costs (plus indirect costs)</li> <li>• Maximum period of performance is <b>3</b> years</li> </ul> <p><b>Partnering PI Option:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maximum funding of <b>\$2M</b> for direct costs (plus indirect costs)</li> <li>• Maximum period of performance is <b>3</b> years</li> </ul>	<p><b>Pre-application (Preproposal):</b> July 7, 2017 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time</p> <p><b>Application:</b> September 28, 2017 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time</p>
